Sustainability at luav with outgoing students

luav deals with the challenge of sustainability, inclusiveness, civic engagement, encouragement and promotion of active citizenship on a daily basis.

The challenge regards academic offer and research actions for its students, PhD students, postgraduates organised by lecturers, collaborators, researchers with the support of the technical-administrative staff.

The same offer is proposed to incoming students, teaching and administrative staff received at luav and is always a stimulus for luav participants of outgoing mobility in aiming at confrontation and integration once abroad.

The central theme developed by luav is reasoning on the transition towards a horizon characterised by respect for the environment.

We invite our outgoing students to do studies about:

- safety of the future of the territory where to investigate changing places through the analysis and design of cities, buildings and infrastructures in the light of a continuous risk control

- the future of heritage, turning the issue of intergenerational and community relations into a valuable testimony that can lead historical memories and heritage of the past into a foreseeable future

- the transition towards new models of relationship with nature and its processes of change, even extreme ones: water, climate, renewable energy, agricultural production and supply chains

- the future of the community and the individual by placing wellbeing at the centre of the processes of building society and the environment through the development of new models for health, nutrition and quality of life

Why international mobility at luav ?

International mobility involves objectives calibrated to a small Italian university with unique international characteristics for its location the lagoon city of Venice.

The organisation of outgoing and incoming mobilities has to bring to luav as results, and impact, an intrinsic engine of updating from stimuli and educational models to be experimented with the exchanges and from the comparison with academic realities in European countries.

Considering the participants one by one, but at the same time also considering the university community testing different didactic and training projects and assessing the impact of them in the experiences of professional application means refining and compensating the skills of the individual participants and more generally the quality and relevance of luav courses.

Consequently luav aims to be a <u>quality university</u> participating in the Modernisation of European Higher Education more inclusive since the project promoted all categories of actors in the academy (students, phds, professors, researchers, trainees, administrative staff)

Results and impact of international mobility at luav

The results and the impact of the project on the mobility participants are in line with expectations of the beneficiaries and with what is stated in Iuav's Erasmus Policy Statement and in international strategies of the partner universities thanks to the comparison involved by participants.

The main outcome is the international excellent character of the proposed academic programmes.

By putting in place preventive and constant checks on them, by activating care and attention, once again it turned out that especially Erasmus+ is a programme suitable to offer the direct beneficiaries and organisers highly instructive experiences, inducing them to develop skills with relevant added value: the spirit of initiative in undertaking new experiences, the value of facing any unforeseen event and the determination to carry out their commitments to the end, drawing the greatest possible educational value from them.

The impact refers to the figure of the planner that the various luav and partners' courses have succeeded in forming: a planner with technical, cultural and personal skills to relate to the local/global world, to develop a vision of modernity with appropriate responses to sustainable design needs in contemporary civil society

The layout is usually curated by students in the field of design and communication in the frame of an internship





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
THE HORIZON EUROPE REQUIREMENT

In a new eligibility criterion to access to Horizon research funding, research performing organisations and higher education establishments are required to have a gender equality plan (GEP) in place. The EC has made this mandatory since 2022



THE GENDER EQUALITY PLAN

A GEP is an official strategic document that defines a series of commitments and actions to promote gender equality within an organization through institutional and cultural change.








Students in gender transition can officially use an alias identity i.e. use a name other than their personal name in daily interactions within the university


