- Albanian Journal of Economy and Business with ISSN 2219-3200:
 - 38 issues published up to December 2023
 - Triannual Publication (3 times per year/ April, Aug. & Dec)
 - Double-blind peer review process

Aim and Scope:

The journal is dedicated to advancing knowledge and fostering innovative solutions in the fields of sustainability and climate change, with a strong emphasis on interdisciplinary research.

The scope includes, but is not limited to, the following areas:

- Natural Sciences: Climate science, atmospheric science, ecology, and geosciences, offering insights into the physical mechanisms, trends, and impacts of climate change.
- Social Sciences: Economics, sociology, psychology, anthropology, and political science, exploring the societal, cultural, and behavioral aspects of sustainability and climate change, as well as the policy and governance frameworks needed for effective mitigation and adaptation.
- Engineering and Technology: Renewable energy systems, sustainable infrastructure, green technology, and innovations that reduce environmental impacts and enhance resource efficiency.
- Biological Sciences: Biodiversity conservation, ecosystem services, and the relationships between ecosystems and climate change.
- Health Sciences: Research on the health implications of climate change, including the spread of diseases, air quality, and the intersection of public health with sustainability.
- Humanities and Arts: Exploring the ethical, philosophical, and cultural dimensions of sustainability and climate change, as well as creative expressions and narratives that inspire action and awareness.
- Urban Planning and Design: Sustainable urban development, smart cities, and inclusive
 urban planning that addresses the challenges of climate change in metropolitan areas.
- Agriculture and Food Systems: Sustainable agriculture practices, food security, and the resilience of food systems in the face of changing climate conditions.
- Business and Management: Sustainable business models, corporate social responsibility, and strategies for integrating sustainability into organizational practices and supply chains.
- Energy and Resource Management: Efficient resource utilization, circular economy principles, and sustainable resource management to reduce environmental impact.
- Education and Communication: Innovative methods for public engagement, science communication, and educational initiatives aimed at raising awareness and promoting informed action on sustainability and climate change.

 - Contribution from NGOs
- First call published: April 2024 (IUAV)

- Finalise the new aspects of journal policies. Deadline: 15 March 2024
- Finalise the "call for articles" of special issue. Deadline: 30 March 2024
- Publish the call. Deadline: 18 April 2024
- Identify potential reviewers (on continuous basis) Associate Board members could propose
